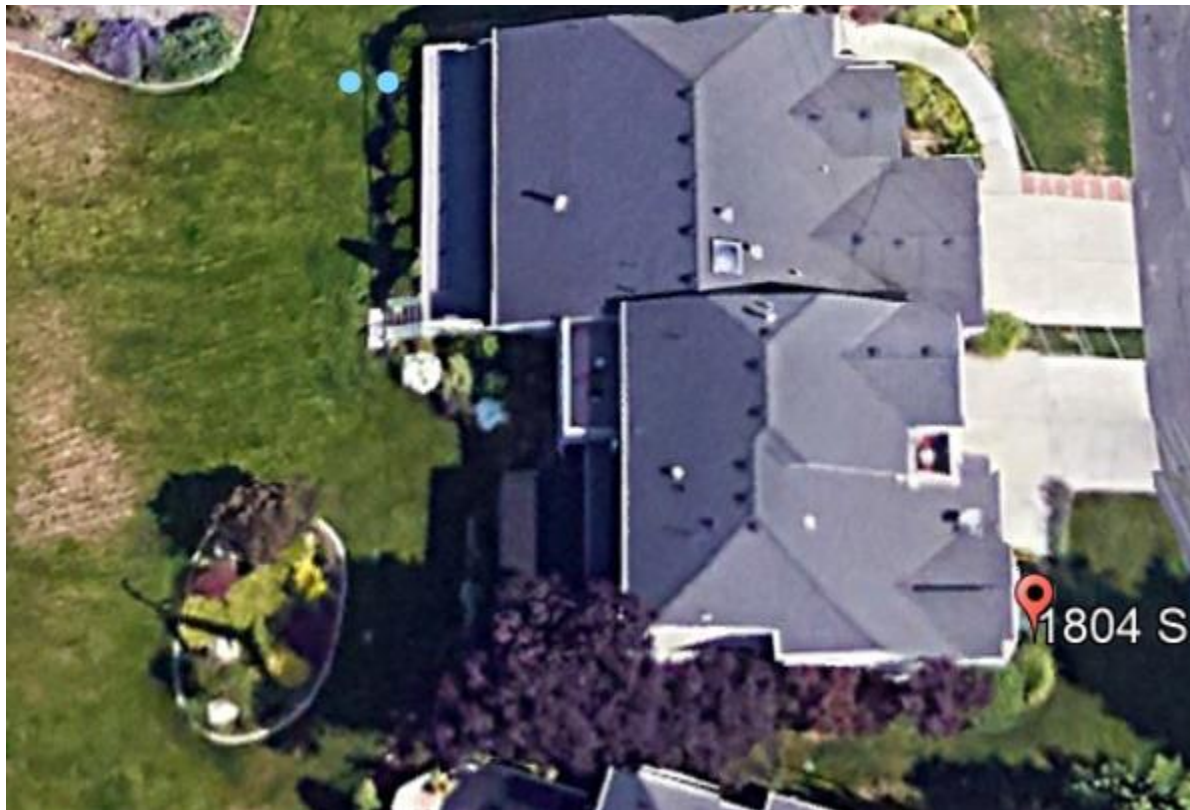


1802-1804 S Viewcrest Septic Tank Locations

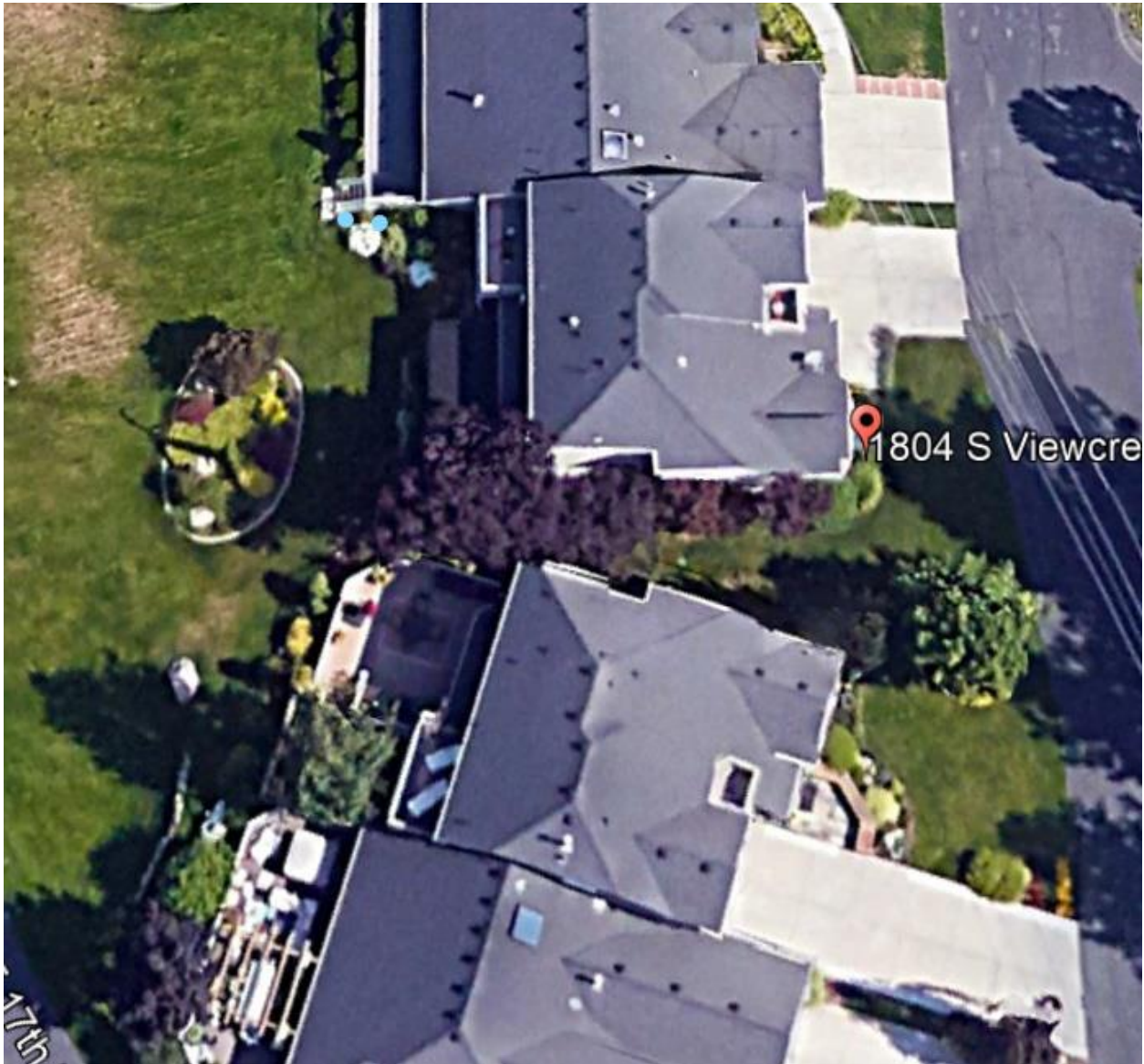


The septic tank locations for 1802-1804 S Viewcrest Ln are identified by the two blue dots, and are just slightly SW of the NW corner of the 1802 deck. They are 3' and 6' feet from the westernmost edge of the deck, and 43" south of the NW corner of the deck. One is just outside the edge of the bed, and one is just inside the edge of the bed. The openings are between 12-14" below ground.

Note: Two Irrigation water lines run along the east edge of both tank openings. Dig carefully



1808-1810 Septic Tank Location



The location of the septic tank openings for 1808-1810 are identified by the blue dots in the flower bed on the west side of 1804. The primary opening is covered by small rocks and is 2' south of the 1802 deck, and 2' east of the top of the deck stairs. The second opening was not specifically located, but is anticipated to be 2-3' directly west of the primary opening close to the bottom of the deck stairs. This will likely require the removal of some plants if the second tank is opened up. The depth of the primary tank lid is approximately 10".

Note: Sprinkler lines and a sprinkler head are very close to the tank openings. Dig carefully.



1813-1817 S Viewcrest Lane Septic Tank Location



The septic tank openings for 1813-1817 S Viewcrest Ln are located directly east and just outside the fence of 1817 S Viewcrest Ln. (Note the blue dot.) There is one opening that is within a rectangular concrete pad with a 24” circular lid. It is immediately accessible when the concrete lid is lifted. The actual location of the second opening is not shown here, but the CS Inspection report below gives some indication of its location.

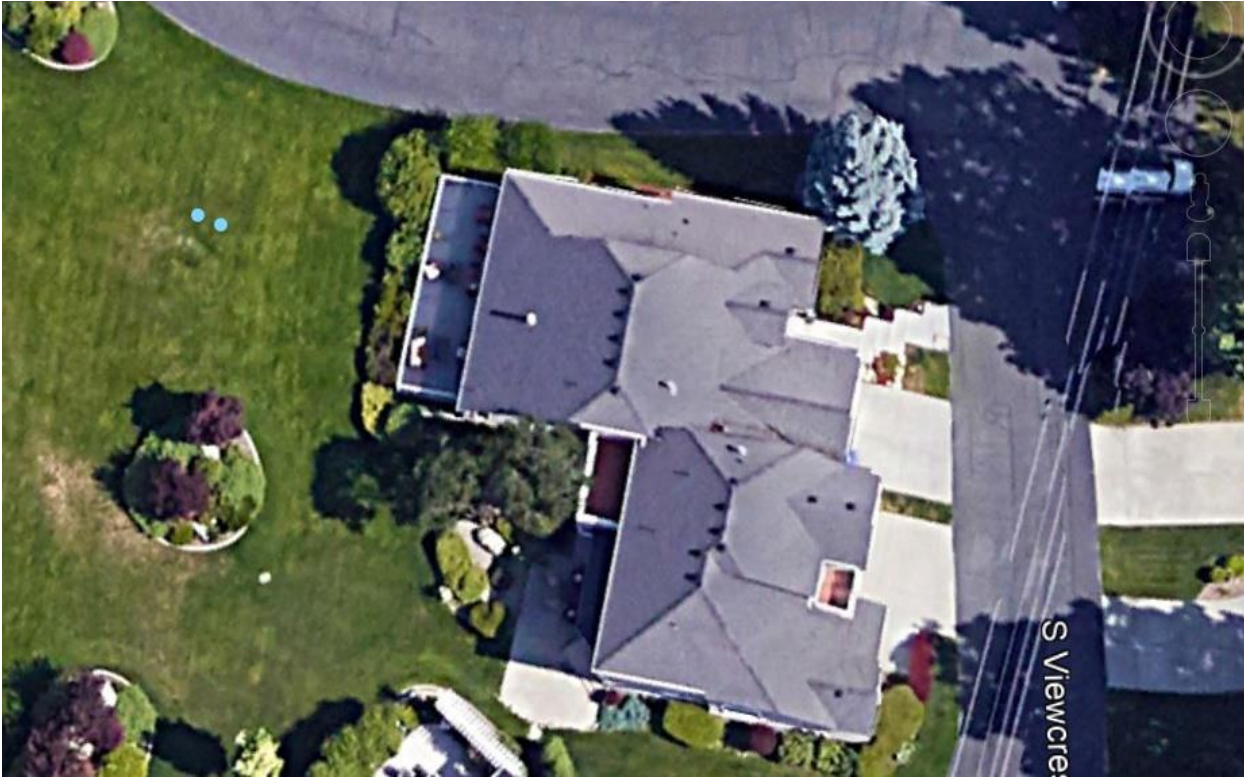

1814-1816 Septic Tank Location



The septic tank openings (as indicated by the blue dots) for 1814-1816 are located 39' east of the edge of deck of 1814. They are also located 31' north of the edge of the major rock in the island to the south. The orienting line for the openings is from the south-most window in the four window configuration on the deck of 1814. (See photos below.) The openings are currently 3'6" below ground. During the pumping/inspection done in October of 2020, risers will be installed over the openings so that the access to the openings will be at ground level in the future.



1819-1821 S. Viewcrest Ln Septic Tank Location

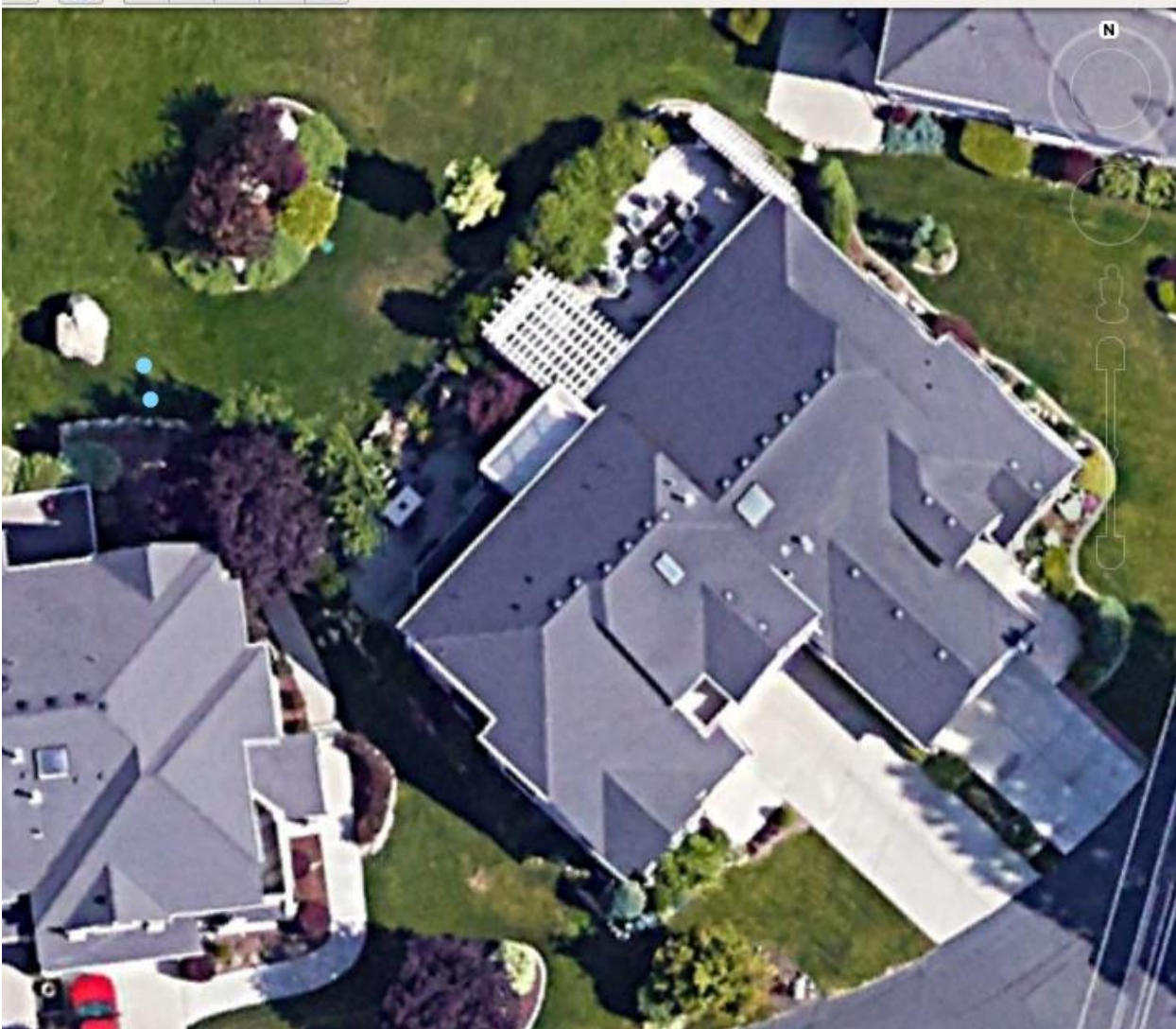


The septic tank openings for 1819-1821 S. Viewcrest Ln are identified by the two blue dots approximately 12' and 17' east of the SE corner of the NE patio wall of 1821. If you were to draw a straight line extending eastward from the north facing wall of the 1821 patio wall, the openings are approximately 12" south of that imaginary line. The openings are between 12"-14" deep under the grass covering and the openings are 24" in diameter.

Note: There is sprinkler control wiring approximately 1.5-2' to the north of the primary tank opening. The shovel in the second photo below is where the sprinkler electrical wire is located. Dig Carefully.



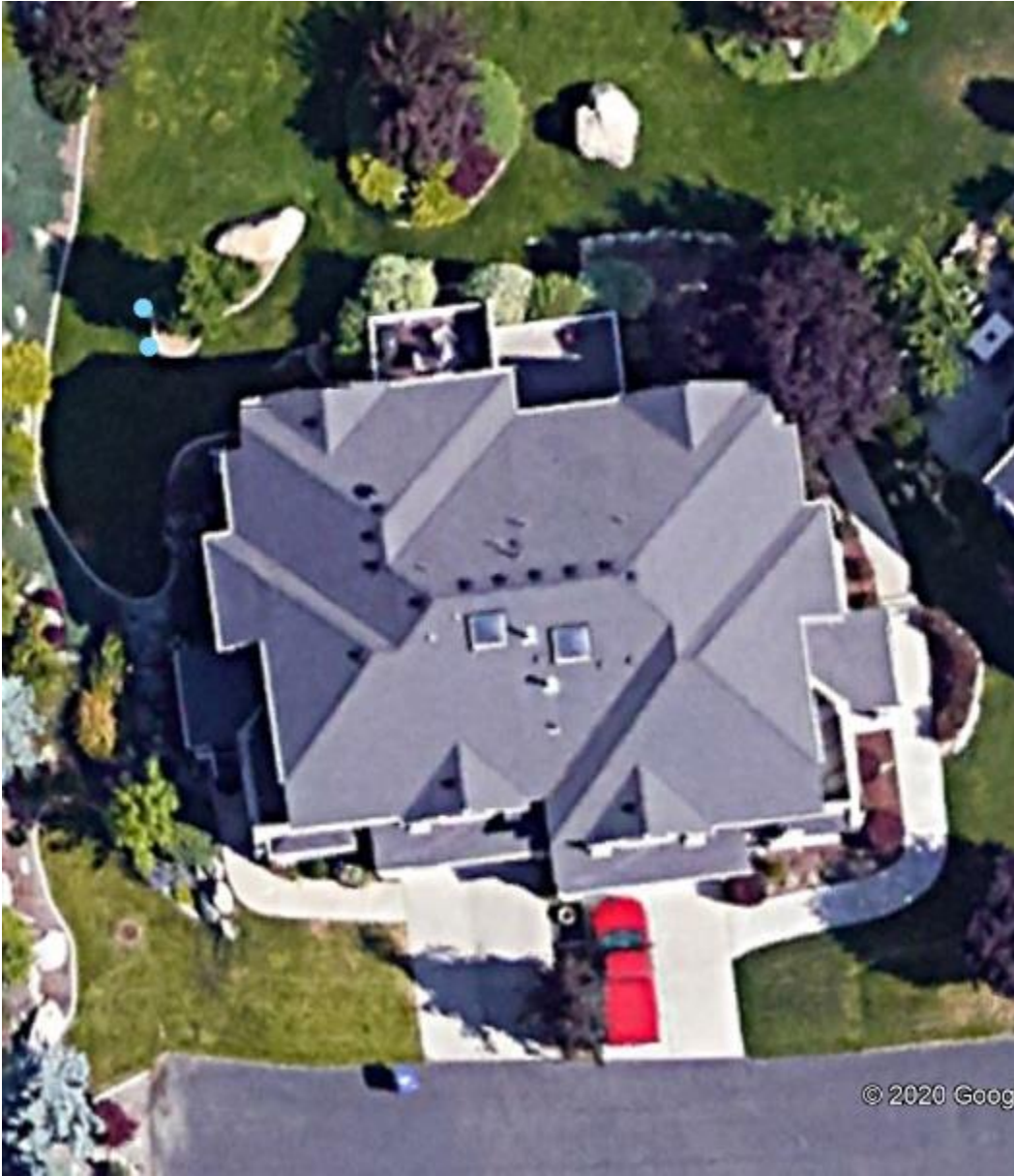
1820-1822 Septic Tank Location



The location of the septic tank openings for 1820-1822 are indicated by the two blue dots which are on the north side of the patio of 1826. The primary opening is 39' from the edge of the 1826 building directly north of the west side of the column on the façade of 1826. The primary opening is also 9.5' SE from the corner of the large rock that is just to the NW of the openings. When measured from the rock wall edging the patio, the primary opening is 3' from the edge of the rock wall. Opening # 2 is approximately 3' to the NNW of the primary opening.



1826-1828 S Viewcrest Lane Septic Tank Locations



The septic tank openings for 1826-1828 S Viewcrest Lane are identified by the blue dots on the southwest corner of the curbed island on the NW corner of 1828 S Viewcrest Lane. The openings are between 4" and 12" under the grass. The lids are 24" in diameter. The openings are partially and just slightly under the island curbing which will require three sections of curbing to be pulled up to access the openings.
